On August 21, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel or deem null and void the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") and associated tariff for Envirowater Company, LLC ("Envirowater"). The Commission granted Envirowater a CCN on February 6, 2004 to construct and operate a sewer system in an unincorporated area of Lincoln County, Missouri in File No. SA-2004-0159 and approved a tariff with Tracking No. YS-2004-1401.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel or deem null and void the CCN based on Staff's motion.

Persons should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter should they object to Staff's motion. The Commission finds that proper persons shall have 30 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
