Dear Judge Woodruff:

On April 17, 2020, The Empire District Electric Company (“Liberty”) filed an application for approval of a Community Solar Pilot Program (“CSPP”), along with proposed tariff sheets. The CSPP was approved by the Commission, CSPP tariff sheets took effect, and Liberty’s first facility under the CSPP, the Prosperity Community Solar Farm, is fully subscribed and operational. At this time, Liberty seeks to officially begin accepting subscriptions for a second CSPP facility. In this regard, please find attached the following revised CSPP tariff sheets:

These sheets bear an issue date of May 24, 2022, and a proposed effective date of July 1, 2022 (instead of the usual 30 days), to allow additional time for Staff’s review of Liberty’s proposed changes without the need for suspension of the tariff sheets.

Like with the first CSPP facility, Liberty requests that there be no upfront, per block charge for the second CSPP facility. These revised tariff sheets contain the estimated facility charge for CSPP-II, and Liberty is also proposing minor changes to the tariff sheets to reflect lessons learned from operation of the first CSPP facility. Redlined tariff sheets are being provided to Staff and OPC and are attached hereto for reference. As part of its general rate case compliance tariff package, Liberty submitted revised sheets for 25a, c, and f (to take effect June 1, 2022). The CSPP sheets being filed at this time assume the effectiveness of the rate case compliance tariff package.
