**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF CONTESTED CASE AND SETTING
INTERVENTION DEADLINE**

On June 29, 2015 Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") as authorized by § 393.170, RSMo 2000. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage solar generation facilities in Montgomery County, Missouri.

This is considered a contested case pursuant to § 536.010(4), RSMo (2013 Cum. Supp.). A contested case is a formal hearing procedure that includes discovery. The Commission's discovery rules are set forth in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Montgomery County, Missouri.

2. The Commission's Public Information Officer shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Montgomery County, Missouri and to the media serving Montgomery County, Missouri.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than July 28, 2015. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission.

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file a status update no later than July 28, 2015, stating when it will file a recommendation on Ameren Missouri's application.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
