COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the Interconnection Agreement between SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. and New Edge Network, Inc. d/b/a New Edge Networks.
- 2. The Commission's authority to approve or reject this Interconnection Agreement is pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 3. The Staff concludes that the Interconnection Agreement does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement, and the Agreement is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.
- 4. The Staff also notes in the Memorandum that it does not have a serially numbered copy of the Agreement and recommends the Commission direct the parties to submit a serially numbered copy of the Agreement.
