MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STAFF REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and moves the Commission for its order extending the time by which the Staff must file its second report in this case. In support thereof, the Staff states as follows:

- 1. On January 18, 2002, the Commission issued its Order Directing Second Staff Report, in which it ordered the Staff to continue to monitor the quality of service that Osage Water Company provides to its customers, and to file its second report on the quality of the Company's service by no later than March 28, 2002.
- 2. Because of the press of other business, including the Staff's participation in the hearing in Case No. WA-2002-65, the preparation of testimony for filing in Case No. WC-2002-155, and proceedings related to the remand of Case No. WA-2000-281 to the Commission, the Staff has not been able to complete preparation of its second report on the quality of service that Osage Water Company provides to its customers. The Staff believes that it will be able to complete preparation of the report by April 8, 2002. The Staff therefore requests that the deadline for filing its second report in this case be extended by ten days, to April 8, 2002.

WHEREFORE, the Staff moves the Commission for its order extending the deadline for filing its second report on the Company's quality of service to April 8, 2002.
