On August 3, 2006, the Commission ordered the Respondents to reply by August 23 to the additional facts asserted in Complainant's response to Respondents' Motion for Summary Determination. On August 16, the Complainant and the Respondents filed a Joint Request for Extension of Time. That motion explains that the parties are presently

negotiating toward a settlement. As a result, they jointly request a three-week extension of time for the Respondents to file their reply.

The request for additional time is reasonable and will be granted.
