

Startec Global Operating Company (“Startec”) and Americatel Corporation (“Americatel”) (collectively, “Applicants”), by their attorneys and pursuant to MRS § 392.300 and 4 CSR 240-3.525, as well as any other applicable statutes or rules, hereby amend their Joint Application seeking authority to complete a *pro forma* corporate restructuring involving the merger of the Applicants, with Americatel surviving, filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) on November 5, 2007 in the above referenced docket.

Specifically, Applicants state as follows:


1. Except as set forth in Exhibit A hereto, there are no pending or final judgments or decisions against Startec or Americatel involving customer service or rate issues.
2. Startec and Americatel have both filed their annual reports, and paid any and all required assessments in Missouri. Startec will file the Company Information Update form on or before December 14, 2007, the date that form is due; Americatel filed that update form on or about December 5, 2007.
3. Documentation from the Missouri Secretary of State authorizing Startec and Americatel to do business in Missouri is attached as Exhibit B hereto.

Exhibit A

Pending or Final Judgments and Decisions

1. On or about June 11, 2007, the California Public Utilities Commission (“CPUC”) issued a citation and fine of \$1,000 to Startec Global Operating Company for alleged violations of the CPUC’s anti-slamming rules. The fine was paid in full.
2. On or about October 3, 2007 and on or about October 29, 2007, the CPUC issued two citations and separate fines of \$1,000 each to Americatel Corporation (“Americatel”) for alleged violations of the CPUC’s anti-slamming rules. Americatel has appealed these citations and the appeals are currently pending.
3. In August 2007, the Public Utility Commission of Texas (“PUCT”) found that Americatel was in violation of the Texas anti-cramming statute because Americatel’s third-party verification procedures allegedly did not comply with the express requirements of the statute. No fines were imposed. In response to the PUCT’s request, Americatel modified its Federally-compliant third-party verification recording procedures to comply with the Texas statute. Due to this change in procedures, the Applicants expect that no further regulatory action will be taken by the PUCT will regard to this issue.

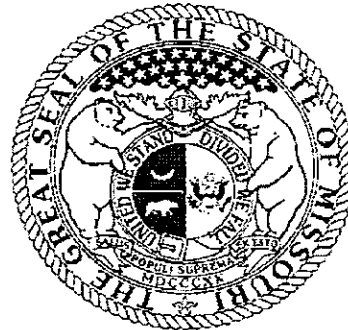

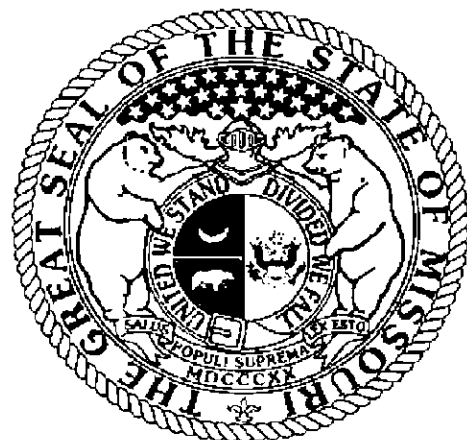


