On February 8, 2011, the Commission's Staff filed a complaint against KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"). A copy of the complaint accompanies this notice. This is a contested case¹ pursuant to Section 386.390, RSMo 2000, although the statutes and Commission regulations allow for a decision without a hearing.²

The Commission will set a deadline for GMO to file an answer. The Commission's discovery rules are located at 4 CSR 240-2.090.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send, by certified mail, a copy of this notice and order, and a copy of the complaint, to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company at:
