STAFF RECOMMENDATION

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COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

On November 5, 2008, Qwest Communications Corporation, a Delaware 1. corporation, filed notification of its change of corporate name due to its conversion from a corporation to a limited liability company. With its notification, Qwest filed revised tariff sheets with a January 2, 2009 effective date. On December 8, 2008 Qwest extended the effective date of the tariffs to January 30, 2009. On January 13, 2009 Qwest submitted a Certificate of Registration from the Missouri Secretary of State.

2. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 provides:

(5) A name change may be accomplished by filing the items below with a cover letter requesting a change of name. Notwithstanding any other provision of these rules, the items required herein may be filed by a non-attorney. Applications for approval of a change of name shall include:

- (A) A statement, clearly setting out both the old name and the new name;
- (B) Evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri secretary of state; and
- (C) Either an adoption notice and revised tariff title sheet with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application, or revised tariff sheets with an effective date which is not fewer than thirty (30) days after the filing date of the application.
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff

recommends that the Commission approve the change of name.

4. The request clearly sets out the old name (Qwest Communications Corporation) and the new name (Qwest Communications Company, LLC). The request includes evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri Secretary of State. Although this does not appear to be a name change affecting customer recognition of the company requiring customer notice under 4 CSR 240-3.545(20), the company will notify customers of the name change.

5. The company has submitted an adoption notice and a revised title page for each of its three tariffs, with the new name clearly identified. Staff has reviewed the new tariff sheets and recommends that the Commission approve those tariff sheets.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order to recognize the name change of Qwest Communications Corporation to Qwest Communications Company, LLC; and approve the tariff sheets filed to effectuate that name change with an effective date of January 30, 2009.
