An Amendment to Application was filed on November 9, 1999, to include the regulatory waivers.

Staff notes that the waiver lists in the Application and tariff do not match the Notice, in that the Notice does not include 392.300.2, which is routinely granted to IXCs. The Commission approved the waiver of Section 392.300.2 for CLECS in case No. TA-96-347 and for IXC's in case no. TA-98-361.
