STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant approval of the Interconnection Agreement between Missouri Telecom, Inc. and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), filed on January 5, 2000 as supplemented by filing made January 19, 2000, with the pages numbered in the lower right hand corner.
- 2. The agreement incorporates the terms of the AT&T/SWBT agreement and those terms were approved by the Commission in Cases Nos. TO-97-40, TO-97-67 and TO-98-115.
- 3. The Staff notes that SWBT filed on January 19, 2000, a pleading stating that it is taking the position that if any change is made in the interconnection agreement between it and AT&T made as the result of pending appeals from Cases Nos. TO-97-40, TO-97-67 and TO-98-115, then this agreement should also automatically be modified to reflect those changes since SWBT only made these terms available due to the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(i).

WHEREFORE, because the Commission determined in Cases Nos. TO-97-40, TO-97-67 and TO-98-115, that the terms set forth in this agreement satisfy the standard set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) in that they do not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and do not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity, the Staff recommends the Commission enter an Order Approving Interconnection Agreement.
