**ORDER REGARDING DISCOVERY**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is denying discovery relief on Eddie Shepherd's filing of October 28<sup>1</sup> ("motion"). The Commission treats the motion as a motion to enforce discovery. On November 14, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed its response to the motion.

a.

Mr. Shepherd seeks:

- The lady who was sent out to see if the meter could be read from the road.

The Commission denied that request on September 2.<sup>2</sup>

b.

Mr. Shepherd seeks:

- The worker that came out with Bill Warner to cut the limb off the line.
- The work order for changing the transformer on the pole.

GMO states that Mr. Warner acted alone and that GMO did not change the transformer. The Commission cannot order GMO to produce what it does not have.

C.

Mr. Shepherd seeks:

- The original meter reader that did not get out of the truck to read the meter.
- The meter reader supervisor's name.

GMO states that it complied with those requests: on September 15<sup>3</sup> and October 11, respectively. But, because Mr. Shepherd claims that he has not received that information, the Commission will order GMO to show its compliance with those requests.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than December 30, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") shall file a response to this order that includes the transmissions by which GMO complied with the discovery requests specified in the body of this order.
2. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
