Safety Standard violations by Respondent intentionally excluded by the present ALJ presiding in EC-2012-0050.

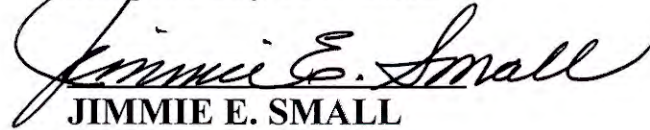

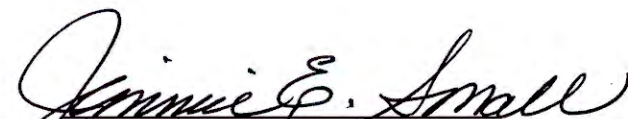

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DEBT COLLECTION LAWS

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Missouri Statute of Limitations on Debt Collection

Written agreement that contemplates the payment of money or property: 10 Years, (Missouri Revised Statute §516.11 0). NOTE: Under certain circumstances, the contractual statute of limitations may be reduced to five years.

Open accounts: 5 years, (Mo. Rev. Stat. §516.120).

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DEBT COLLECTION LAWS

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Iowa Statute of Limitations on Debt Collection

Open account: 5 years from last charge, payment, or admission of debt in writing. Unwritten contracts: 5 years from breach ✓ *5/5*

Written contracts: 10 years from breach.

Demand note: 10 years from date of note.

Judgments: 20 years. However, an action brought on a judgment after nine years but not more than ten years can be brought to renew the judgment.

NOTE: Deficiency judgments on most residential foreclosures, and judgments on mortgage notes are without value two years from date of judgment.
