SECOND NOTICE REGARDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Issue Date: February 21, 2007

During the evidentiary hearing on January 24, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission ordered two rounds of posthearing briefs in this case. On January 26, 2007, the Commission issued a Notice of Briefing Schedule advising the parties that initial briefs were to be filed no later than 30 days from the date the transcript of the hearing is filed and that reply briefs shall be filed no later than 44 days from the date the transcript is filed.

The Commission received the official copy of the hearing transcript approximately two weeks after the hearing. However, the Commission rejected that transcript because it contained transcription errors. The Commission has not yet received a corrected copy of the transcript. The Commission will file the corrected copy of the transcript as soon as it is received. To avoid any additional confusion the Commission will issue a notice setting out with specificity the dates by which the parties must file their initial and reply briefs after the transcript is filed.
