ORDER DENYING MOTION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is denying relief on Craig Mershon's letter dated August 30¹ ("motion") because Mr. Mershon is not now threatened with disconnection. Mr. Mershon filed the motion on September 9. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an expedited response on September 12, 2013.

The motion suggests, though it does not expressly state, that Mr. Mershon is under threat of disconnection. The response alleges that the status of Mr. Mershon's account as of the date of this order includes the following:

- A disputed amount of \$608.12.
- An undisputed amount due of \$86.59 of which \$18.81 is delinquent.
- Earlier disconnection notices, issued erroneously, have been rescinded with actual notice to Mr. Mershon.

Those allegations are sufficient to rebut the suggestion that Mr. Mershon is under threat of disconnection and the remainder of the motion addresses the merits of Mr. Mershon's complaint.

Therefore, the Commission will deny relief on the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Relief on the motion as described in the body of this order is denied.
2. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
