**ORDER SETTING PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE AND SETTING
CONDITIONS ON COMMUNICATIONS**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is re-setting the pre-hearing conference based on the request of Craig Mershon made by telephone on September 12, 2013. In that call, Mr. Mershon described circumstances that make hard-copy filings difficult for him. Therefore, the Commission will set conditions for email contact with the regulatory law judge assigned to this action.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The September 17, 2013, pre-hearing conference is cancelled.
2. The Commission will convene a pre-hearing conference on October 1, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. Any appearance may be either in person or through counsel, and may be either in the hearing room or by telephone. Any appearance by telephone shall be made by dialing [526-5398 local](tel:526-5398) or [866-630-9345 long distance](tel:866-630-9345) at the pre-hearing conference's start time.

3. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional accommodations to participate in the pre-hearing conference shall contact the Commission not later than the day before the conference. Such contact shall be through the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711.

4. If timely filing of any request for any ruling is impossible for Mr. Mershon, he may communicate with the regulatory law judge assigned to this action by email. Any such communication shall be copied to all other parties. Otherwise, Mr. Mershon shall make his filings as provided in the Commission's regulations as set forth at 4 CSR 240-2.

5. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
