ORDER DENYING MOTIONS

On July 2, 2014, the Commission issued its *Order Denying Application for Rehearing*.¹ Complainant Craig Mershon then filed with the Commission his *Objection to the Denial of Mr. Craig Mershon’s Preliminary Response to Mr. Daniel Jordans Report and Order* [sic]² and *Motion to Extend Time to File the Preliminary Response to the Report and Order*. Neither the motion nor the objection filed by Mr. Mershon states material or relevant issues relating to the Commission’s July 2nd Order. Therefore, the Commission will deny Mr. Mershon’s motion and “objection.”

Pursuant to § 386.510, RSMo (Cum.Supp.2013), Mr. Mershon has thirty days from the time the Commission denied his application for rehearing to file a notice of appeal. The filing of objections or motions with the Commission does not stop or extend the thirty days deadline. Should Mr. Mershon wish to appeal

the Commission's decision in the appellate court, he must comply with the requirements of that statute. A copy of § 386.510 will be provided with this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Complainant Craig Mershon's *Motion to Extend Time to File the Preliminary Response to the Report and Order and Objection to the Denial of Mr. Craig Mershon's Preliminary Response to Mr. Daniel Jordans Report and Order* [sic] are denied.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of Section 386.510 of the Missouri Revised Statutes to complainant with a copy of this order.

3. This order is effective upon issuance.
