- JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. We're going to go
- 3 ahead and go on the record. Good morning. It's
- 4 Wednesday, January 20th, 2010. We are here for a
- 5 prehearing conference in the File No. SC-2010-0150, et
- 6 al., which is a consolidation of four complaint cases
- 7 captioned the Staff of the Missouri Public Service
- 8 Commission versus Aqua Development Company doing business
