> Telephone's transition plan. Can you tell me if the following  
> transition plan still stands or has it changed? Currently, we show  
> that Big River has 7,184 UNE-P circuits in Missouri.

> Negotiated LWC - 10% will be placed on a negotiated LWC by 2/28/06.

> UNE-P to UNE-L Conversion - 80% will be transitioned to BRT's  
> facilities by 2/28/06.

> UNE-P to RESALE Conversion - 10% will be placed on resale by the end  
> of 2/28/06.

> Could you please provide me specific numbers for the UNEP to UNEL and  
> UNEP to RESALE conversions? I need this information, because these  
> conversions will need to be negotiated with the LSC, LOC, and  
> downstream departments. I will facilitate the project negotiations  
> with these departments, but I cannot proceed without volumes from you.  
> Your help would be great.

> Approximately 1,000 lines have already been transitioned to BRT's  
> facilities The remaining 6,000 lines can be broken down this way:  
>  
>     Approximately 80% will be transitioned to BRT's facilities by the end  
> of February, 2006  
>     Approximately 10% will be placed on a negotiated LWC by the end of  
> February, 2006  
>     Approximately 10% will be placed on resale by the end of February,  
> 2006.
