OZARK MEADOWS SECOND CUSTOMER NOTICE AND NOTICE OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING January 27, 2010

On July 15, 2009, Aqua Missouri, Inc. (Company) submitted a request for an increase in its annual sewer operating revenues for Ozark Meadows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) under the provisions of the PSC's small utility rate case procedure. As a result of the Company's request, the Staff of the PSC conducted an independent audit of the Company's books and records, and an investigation of the Company's business and system operations. Based upon the results of the audit and investigation, and negotiations conducted between the PSC Staff and the Company, the PSC Staff and the Company have reached an agreement, which if approved by the Commission would result in an increase of \$3,305 in the Company's annual sewer operating revenues.

If approved, the agreement would increase the residential customer monthly flat charge from \$50.43 to \$63.82, and would increase the residential metered minimum charge from \$36.06 to \$45.64 with an increase from \$2.875 to \$3.639 for each 1000 gallons used.

The Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), a state agency responsible for representing the interests of utility consumers before the PSC, has not signed the agreement and has requested the PSC to hold local public hearings to allow the Company's customers to comment on the proposed increase in rates or any recent service-related problems.
