## STAFF'S RESPONSE TO COVAD'S MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEUDLE AND FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its response states:

- 1. On December 27, 1999, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an Order Adopting Procedural Schedule for this case which established, *inter alia*, a filing date of February 3, 2000, for surrebuttal testimony, and evidentiary hearing dates of February 8-9, 15, 2000.
- 2. On January 27, 2000, DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad Communications Company (Covad) submitted by facsimile transmission a motion requesting that the procedural schedule be modified to establish a filing date of February 10, 2000, for surrebuttal testimony and evidentiary hearing dates of February 15-16, 2000. Covad requested the change in schedule to allow it time to review information which the Commission in its January 25, 2000, Order Regarding Motion To Compel Responses directed Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to make available to Covad by February 4, 2000, and due to the recent illness of its lead counsel.



3. The Staff supports Covad's proposed modification of the procedural schedule.
