**STATUS REPORT**

On September 18, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an Order Directing Parties to Report, concerning the status of the matter underlying the complaint in this matter.

Union Electric Company d/b/a/ AmerenUE ("the Company") filed its status report, as directed, on October 10, 2000. In that report, the Company indicated a crew was scheduled for October 13 to complete the connection that would provide service at the Complainant's property. The Company therefore suggested that an additional report be submitted to the Commission by October 31, indicating whether the service connection has been completed.



On October 19, the Complainant informed the Company that he did not object to our request that the complaint be withdrawn and that the case be closed.
