FIRST STATUS REPORT

On April 15, 2020, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued in this case its *Order Approving Variance* ("Order"). In that *Order*, the Commission granted Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company") variance from Tariff Sheet Nos. 160.1 and 160.2, which places limits on missed, late, or partial payments a customer may make and remain in the Keeping Current Program. The *Order also* requires Ameren Missouri to submit a status report every 30 days regarding when it believes it will file its 15-day notice to reinstate the tariff provisions for which the variance was granted. The Company submits this first Status Report and states that at this time, it does not anticipate reinstating the tariff provisions within the next 30 days. Should this change, Ameren Missouri will notify the Commission at least 20 days (or, at least five days before it provides its 15-day notice to customers) before the reinstatement of the restrictions.
