Re: Electric service to irrigation well on north side of Highway 60



We recently discussed the electric service connection to your irrigation well located on the north side of Highway 60, east of Highway 61. AmerenUE recommends that you apply to the Missouri Public Service Commission for a change of electric service provider for this well, from AmerenUE to the Sikeston Board of Municipal Utilities. AmerenUE is agreeable to this change for the following reasons:

- 1) We own and maintain about 1,600 feet of 2-phase, 12.47 kV overhead pole line and associated transformer and service facilities on the north side of Highway 60 for the sole purpose of providing electric service to the referenced irrigation well. We have no potential for adding any customers to this line because the entire area on the north side of Highway 60 is now within the City Limits of Sikeston.
- 2) During the last 12 months, you have consumed no energy on the referenced connection. Our only revenue has been the monthly meter charge of \$15.10. Our billing records from 1999 and 2000 indicate only relatively light usage during the summer months each year and no usage the rest of the time. It is doubtful that the revenue generated justifies the existence of the line and related facilities. Copies of the billing histories are enclosed.
- 3) Our line runs through a highly developable area inside the City limits of Sikeston. We do not wish for our line to be a barrier to the development of the area and the growth of the City.
