On December 7, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting YourTel America, Inc.'s ("YourTel") certificates of service authority and accompanying tariffs to provide competitive basic local and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted YourTel a certificate of service authority to provide competitive basic local and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Numbers TA-99-115 and XA-2003-0118.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificates based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
