STATUS REPORT

On September 18, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an Order Directing Parties to Report, concerning the status of the matter underlying the complaint in this matter.

Union Electric Company d/b/a/ AmerenUE ("the Company") hereby submits its report as directed:

1. This matter concerns a request for three-phase electric service. The Company can report that it has been working with the Complainant on the request, and the extension is almost complete.
2. The Company has installed a new pole and transformer and extended three-phase service to that point. The meter on Complainant's property has been installed and conduit laid from the building to the pole.
3. Complainant's electrician is scheduled to pull the wire from the meter to the pole tomorrow, October 11.
4. If this work is completed, the Company has scheduled a crew for October 13 to

complete the connection, and service will be available.

The Company suggests that an additional report be submitted to the Commission by October 31, indicating whether the service connection has been completed.

Upon the completion of that connection, the Company will request the dismissal of this Complaint. While the Commission might prefer a Joint Request, the Company has not had very good luck getting cooperation from the Complainant on procedural matters – so that a Joint Request may not be possible.

Unless directed otherwise, the Company will attempt to have the Complainant join in a request for dismissal, or if unsuccessful in that attempt, the Company will inform the Commission as to the Company's efforts and the result thereof, when it files its next status report.
