STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW UtiliCorp United Inc. ("UtiliCorp"), Applicant in the captioned matter, and states to the Commission as follows:

- 1. On April 11, 2000, UtiliCorp caused to be filed with the Commission an *Application* in the captioned matter. The Application seeks an order authorizing UtiliCorp to acquire, indirectly, up to and including 45% of the capital stock of AlintaGas, an Australian natural gas distribution, retail and marketing business being privatized by the West Australian Government.
- 2. Thereafter, on April 13, 2000, UtiliCorp filed a *Motion for Expedited Consideration* requesting that the Commission issue an order approving the Application bearing an effective date of no later than June 8, 2000.
- 3. UtiliCorp's Application described the general outline of the bidding process for AlintaGas. Along those lines, UtiliCorp reported to the Commission that it had already placed a non-binding, indicative bid from which the West Australian Government was to choose a number of finalists from which the successful bidder would ultimately be chosen.
- 4. UtiliCorp is pleased to report to the Commission that it has been chosen as one of the finalists in this process. Attached for the Commission's information is a copy of a Dow Jones press release dated April 14, 2000, stating that UtiliCorp is one of four companies chosen by the West Australian government and placed on a "short list" of bidders for AlintaGas.

*W Australia Names Short Leted Bidders For AlintaGas Dow Jones - 04/14/2000

PERTH - The state government of Western Australia Friday said four companies have been shortlisted as potential "cornerstone" investors in AlintaGas, the government's A\$1 billion natural gas utility.

The four companies are Australian Gas Light Co. (A.AGL), a gas distribution company, and Wesfarmers Ltd. (A.WES), a chemicals, energy, rural services and hardware concern; and U.S. companies UtiliCorp United Inc. (UCU) and CMS Energy Corp. (CMS).

The four will have in-depth access to AlintaGas' commercial data from May 1, at the start of the due diligence and final bid stage.

Final bids are due around eight weeks later, and the government plans to announce the successful bidder at the end of June.

"The successful cornerstone investor would acquire 45% of AlintaGas with the other 55% being made available to the public through an initial public offering in July or August," the government said.
