



ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFFS

On May 27, 1988, Teleconnect Long Distance Services and Systems Company
(Teleconnect) filed tariffs designed to establish operator services in this state.

On June 3, 1988, Dial U.S. and Dial U.S.A. also filed tariffs designed to establish operator services in the State of Missouri. On June 17, 1988, the Commission suspended the tariffs of Dial U.S., Dial U.S.A and Teleconnect for 120 days beyond their requested effective date to October 25, 1988.

On October 14, 1987, International Telecharge, Inc. (ITI) filed tariffs to establish reseller and operator services in the State of Missouri. ITI requested an effective date for these tariffs which was extended to August 1, 1988. On July 15, 1988, the Commission suspended the tariffs of ITI for 120 days beyond their requested effective date to November 29, 1988. On August 5, 1988, ITI revised some of these tariff sheets by filing substitutions for the original sheets filed.

Since it is apparent that the investigation of these tariffs cannot be completed within 120 days, the Commission determines that these tariffs should be further suspended for a period of six months beyond their 120-day suspension periods unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED: 1. That the tariffs filed by Teleconnect Long Distance Services and Systems Company on May 27, 1988, designed to establish operator services in the State of Missouri, are further suspended hereby for a period of six (6) months beyond October 25, 1988, to April 25, 1989, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED: 2. That the tariffs filed by Dial U.S. and Dial U.S.A. on June 3, 1988, designed to establish operator services in the State of Missouri, are further suspended hereby for a period of six (6) months beyond October 25, 1988, to April 25, 1989, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED: 3. That the tariffs submitted by International Telecharge, Inc. on October 14, 1987, designed to establish reseller and operator services within the State of Missouri, as revised by ITI on August 5, 1988, are further suspended hereby for a period of six (6) months beyond November 29, 1988, to May 29, 1989, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED: 4. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.


