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- 1 PROCEEDINGS
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Good morning. We're
- 3 on the record. This is the settlement conference for
- 4 Case Nos. SC-2005-0083, Gerald and Joanne Reierson versus
- 5 Kenneth Jaeger and Blue Lagoon Sewer Corporation, and
- 6 SC-2005-0099, Robert M. Hallibush versus Kenneth Jaeger
- 7 and Blue Lagoon Sewer Corporation.
- 8 I'm Ron Pridgin. I'm the Regulatory Law Judge
- 9 assigned to preside over this settlement conference being
- 10 held on April 5th, 2007, in the Governor's office in
- 11 Jefferson City, Missouri. The time is approximately ten
- 12 after 10 a.m.
- I would like to get entries of appearance from
- 14 counsel, beginning with the General Counsel's office,
- 15 please.
- MR. KRUEGER: Keith R. Krueger for the Staff of
- 17 the Missouri Public Service Commission. My address is
- 18 P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.
- 19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Krueger, thank you. On
- 20 behalf of Kenneth Jeager and Blue Lagoon Sewer
- 21 Corporation?
- 22 MS. MORROW NUTT: Meredith Morrow Nutt here for
- 23 James Lemon, Address 119 South 10th Street, Hannibal,
- 24 Missouri, 63401.
- 25 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Thank you very much.

- 1 On behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel, please?
- MS. BAKER: Thank you, your Honor. Christina
- 3 Baker, P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.
- 4 Appearing for the Office of Public Counsel and the
- 5 ratepayers.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Baker, thank you. Any entry
- 7 on behalf of Gerald or Joanne Reierson? Hearing none,
- 8 we'll mark that they are not present. Any entry on behalf
- 9 of Robert Hallibush? Hearing none, we'll mark that they
- 10 are not present.
- 11 And down for Blue Lagoon -- I'm sorry. I
- 12 neglected to get your name. Could you state your name for
- 13 me again, please?
- MS. MORROW NUTT: Meredith Morrow Nutt, spelled
- 15 M-e-r-e-d-i-t-h M-o-r-r-o-w N-u-t-t. There's no hyphen.
- 16 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Thank you very much.
- 17 Let me go over a couple of things, and then I'll -- I'll
- 18 try to address any concerns that you have. And -- and
- 19 part of the problem here is we don't have the complainants
- 20 in person. Hopefully, they will either show up shortly or
- 21 will be able to speak to you by phone in a little bit.
- 22 And do you prefer to be called Ms. Morrow?
- MS. MORROW NUTT: Ms. -- Ms. Nutt is fine.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Nutt. All right. Thank
- 25 you. I'm sorry. I know the -- unless my file is

- 1 mistaken, that I ordered rebuttal testimony to be filed by
- 2 March 29th, and I don't have any testimony or -- or motion
- 3 for leave to late file or any explanation. Do you have
- 4 any explanation as to why we haven't received any
- 5 testimony?
- 6 MS. MORROW NUTT: My understanding is that there
- 7 is no rebuttal testimony.
- 8 JUDGE PRIDGIN: I can certainly -- certainly
- 9 recheck my order. Mr. Krueger, does that sound accurate
- 10 to you?
- 11 MR. KRUEGER: Yes, it does. I spoke with
- 12 Mr. Lemon yesterday, and he said that -- that it was not
- 13 an oversight, that it was not intended to -- they did not
- 14 intend to file rebuttal testimony. Is that correct?
- MS. MORROW NUTT: That is my understanding.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: That's fine. If you have no
- 17 testimony, that's fine. We'll note for the record that
- 18 you'll not be filing any rebuttal. I note -- and I don't
- 19 have the complainants here to tell them this, and the
- 20 parties can certainly feel free to -- to speak for me.
- 21 It looks like -- I forget which of the
- 22 complainants, or maybe both of them, are asking for the
- 23 Commission to order Cannon Water District to take over
- 24 these facilities.
- 25 And upon my review of the statute that they've

- 1 cited and looking at the Secretary of State's records, it
- 2 looks like that Cannon Water District is a Chapter 247
- 3 water district and that the statute that they're using
- 4 excludes a public water district from being a capable
- 5 public utility under the statue.
- And so I'm -- I'm rather doubtful that -- that
- 7 the Commission can give them what they're asking for. I'm
- 8 not a Commissioner. I don't get a vote. So that's -- I
- 9 mean, you can take that for what it's worth, but it's my
- 10 reading of the statute that they've got a problem.
- 11 That's not to say that, you know, the parties
- 12 are in any way discouraged from trying to negotiate some
- 13 resolution where the water district might -- might take
- 14 over. And, obviously, the Commission has the authority to
- 15 order a server.
- 16 And I don't know if Cannon is a -- is a
- 17 potential server for these assets if the Commission
- 18 determines that -- that Blue Lagoon is not providing safe
- 19 and adequate service. I guess without the -- without the
- 20 complainants being here, that's kind of the short version
- 21 of -- of the comments that I have.
- Is there anything that Counsel wishes to bring
- 23 to my attention? Any pending motions or anything I need
- 24 to know about?
- 25 MR. KRUEGER: Not from Staff, your Honor.

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1 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right.
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- MS. BAKER: Not from Public Counsel.
- 3 MS. MORROW NUTT: Not from us either.
- 4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Thank you very much,
- 5 Counsel. I believe we are set for hearing on April 26th,
- 6 if I'm not mistaken. And I'm trying to think of what else
- 7 -- I'm assuming we're not going to get any further
- 8 testimony since we have no rebuttal.
- 9 Ms. Baker, has OPC filed any testimony?
- MS. BAKER: No, we have not, and we do not
- 11 intend to.
- 12 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. I did not think so. So
- 13 it looks like that would leave as the next item on April
- 14 17th date of list of issues, order of witnesses and order
- 15 of cross. So if there's nothing further from counsel --
- 16 all right. You have access to this room until 5:00.
- 17 Normally, I would be here the remainder of the
- 18 day, but -- but I will be leaving shortly and will be
- 19 unavailable. But you can certainly contact me next week
- 20 if you have any scheduling issues.
- 21 I've got a conference phone here if you need to
- 22 use it to try to contact the complainants and speak with
- 23 them. If there's anything else from counsel?
- MR. KRUEGER: No, your Honor.
- MS. MORROW NUTT: No.
