**ORDER CANCELING IXC CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF**

Issue Date: February 19, 2008

Effective Date: February 29, 2008

On January 4, 2005, the Commission approved the merger of Intermedia Communications, Inc. and MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC. As part of that order, the Commission cancelled Intermedia's competitive local exchange certificate and accompanying tariffs. On February 5, 2008, the Commission's Staff filed a pleading indicating the Commission should have also cancelled Intermedia's IXC certificate and accompanying tariff. Staff indicates it has discussed this matter with counsel for Intermedia and represents that Intermedia agrees its certificate and tariff should be cancelled. No party has responded to Staff's pleading

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will cancel Intermedia's IXC certificate and accompanying tariff.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Certificate of Service Authority to provide competitive interexchange telecommunications services granted to Intermedia Communications, Inc., is cancelled.
2. The following tariff filed by Intermedia Communications, Inc., is cancelled:

3. This order shall become effective on February 29, 2008.
4. This case shall be closed on March 1, 2008.
