APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Comes now the City of Rolla, Missouri, by and through Rolla Municipal Utilities, by counsel, and for its application to intervene pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075, respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On May 26, 2000, the Commission issued an "Order and Notice" in this proceeding which described a Territorial Agreement entered into between Intercounty Electric Cooperative Association and Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. It established an intervention deadline of June 15, 2000. The Commission directed that notice be sent to the municipal government of the City of Rolla and other cities located within the territory described in the Territorial Agreement. The City of Rolla owns and operates a municipally-owned electric utility which serves the City of Rolla in Phelps County. The City has made a preliminary inquiry into this matter and has determined that it should seek intervention to protect its interests.
- 2. Based upon a preliminary review of the proposal, the City is not aware of any provision which would be adverse to the City and therefore, on a preliminary basis, does not oppose the Territorial Agreement in its present form. The City is aware, however, that territorial

agreements previously filed with the Commission have been changed during the Commission review process. Therefore, to ensure by its participation that no changes are made which would be adverse to the City's interest, the City seeks to intervene as a party to monitor and protect its interests.

- 3. The City is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri. The City provides electric service through its municipally-owned and operated Board of Public Works. The principal office and place of business of Rolla Municipal Utilities is 102 West 9th Street, Rolla, Missouri 65402-0767.
- 4. All pleadings, correspondence, communications, notices, and orders in regard to this proceeding should be addressed to the following:

5. The City has an interest in this proceeding which is different from that of the general public since the City is an electric service supplier located within the territory covered by the Territorial Agreement. The City is also specifically mentioned in paragraph 6 of the Territorial Agreement and therefore the City assumes that the agreement establishes certain rights between the parties pertaining to the City.

- 6. The Commission's rules provide for intervention on a showing that (A) the applicant for intervention has an interest in the proceeding which is different from that of the general public; or (B) granting intervention would serve the public interest. Only one of the above is required to be demonstrated for intervention. The City respectfully submits that it meets the first test because of the foregoing. It also submits that it meets the second test because it will serve the public interest to have as a party a municipal electric supplier to monitor the review process.
- 7. For purposes of 4 CSR 240-2.075(2), the City states that, on a preliminary basis, it does not oppose the approval of the Territorial Agreement in its present form. However, this shall not be considered to preclude the City from identifying objectionable provisions later in the course of this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, having stated its grounds for seeking intervention, the City of Rolla requests an order from the Commission granting it intervention in this proceeding.
