## APPLICATION TO INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS LOCAL UNION NO. 1474 TO INTERVENE

Comes now International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union No. 1474 ("Local 1474"), and in support of its Application to Intervene respectfully states as follows:

- 1. Local 1474 is a labor organization as defined in the National Labor Relations Act, as amended, 29 U.S.C. Section 152, *et seq.* Local 1474 represents certain employees of Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), and has a collective bargaining agreement with Empire covering the employees it represents.
- 2. The Empire employees represented by Local 1474 may, and are likely to, be affected by orders entered by the Commission in this proceeding and, accordingly, Local 1474 and the employees it represents are interested in this proceeding.
- 3. Because Local 1474 and the employees it represents may, and are likely to, be directly affected by the Commission's decisions and orders in this case, Local 1474 and the employees it represents have a direct interest in this proceeding which is different from that of the general public, and which cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Furthermore, granting the proposed intervention will serve the public interest because it will ensure that the rights of the employees represented by Local 1474 are adequately protected.

4. While Local 1474 does not currently have sufficient information to support or oppose the

proposed merger between Empire and UtiliCorp United Inc., Local 1474 is concerned that

decisions or orders of the Commission herein could adversely affect the wages, benefits, work

opportunities, safety and other terms and conditions of employment of the Empire employees

represented by Local 1474.

5. In its Order and Notice dated December 16, 1999, the Commission set an intervention

date for this case of January 14, 2000. Local 1474 submits that it meets the criteria for

intervention set forth in 4 CSR 240-2.075 and, accordingly, that its Application to Intervene

should be granted.
