STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro ("Evergy Missouri Metro") and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West ("Evergy Missouri West") (collectively "Evergy" or the "Company") and for this *Status Report* ("Status Report") respectfully states as follows:

1. On April 1, 2022, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued its *Order Granting Extension of Time to File Settlement Agreement or Status Report* ("Order") which directed the parties to file a status report by May 2, 2022, advising the Commission whether or not it is believed that ongoing settlement discussions will result in settlement.

2. On May 2, 2022, the Company filed a status report requesting an extension until May 23, 2022 due to continuing settlement discussions.

3. The Commission granted the Company's extension request pursuant to its *Order Granting Second Extension of Time to File Settlement Agreement or Status Report* issued on May 3, 2022. 4. On May 23, 2022, the Company filed a status report requesting an extension until June 6, 2022 due to continuing settlement discussions.

5. The Commission granted the Company's extension request pursuant to its *Order Granting Third Extension of Time to File Settlement Agreement or Status Report* issued on May 24, 2022.

6. The Company and the other parties have been actively engaged in discussions concerning a possible resolution of this matter. The parties have been conducting settlement discussions and request additional time to continue these discussions. The Company requests an extension until July 5, 2022, to file a settlement agreement or another status report.

7. Counsel for all parties have been apprised of the contents of this pleading and have authorized undersigned counsel to represent that no party has expressed an objection to the request made herein.
