STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty (“Liberty” or the “Company”), and for this Status Report, respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (the “Commission”):

1. On August 22, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (“Staff”) filed its Motion for Extension of Time, stating: “Staff and Liberty engaged in productive discussions over settlement terms. Staff and Liberty agree that additional time is required to continue discussions and seek a resolution to the case.”
2. The Commission granted Staff’s motion, and Staff and Liberty have continued to engage in productive settlement discussions regarding Liberty’s proposed tariff changes.
3. Staff and Liberty agree that additional time is required to finalize the revisions that should be made at this time to Liberty’s “Community Solar Pilot Program” tariff sheets.
4. Liberty anticipates filing revised tariff sheets within ten days.

WHEREFORE, Liberty submits this Status Report and requests such relief as is just and proper under the circumstances.
