STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., (“Confluence Rivers”) and for its *Status Report* respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 9, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Acquisition of Water and Sewer Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* (“*Order*”) in this case. The *Order* set forth a schedule for filing status reports to apprise the Commission of the status of closing on each utility system’s assets.

2. In compliance with the Commission’s *Order*, effective January 8, 2021, Confluence Rivers states that the closing on the utility system assets of Fawn Lake Water Corp. (“Fawn Lake”) has yet to occur. Fawn Lake continues to work with the homeowner’s association for the release of all liens on the utility system assets.

3. Confluence Rivers anticipates closing on the Fawn Lake utility system assets in the next thirty days.

WHEREFORE, Confluence Rivers respectfully submits this *Status Report* to the Commission.
