ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT FOR LACK OF JURISDICTION

Issue Date: September 24, 2014 Effective Date: October 4, 2014

Janice Shands filed this complaint against the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD). MSD was organized under Article VI, Section 30(a) of the Missouri Constitution as a sewer district and is granted authority to set its rates and charges.¹ The Commission is created by statute and has only that power granted to it by the legislature.² Because the power to regulate the district has not been conferred by the legislature on the Commission,³ the Commission must dismiss this complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This complaint is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.
