**ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING AGREEMENT TO MEDIATE, STAYING
PROCEEDINGS, APPOINTING MEDIATOR, AND DIRECTING FILING**

On December 24, 2014, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") filed a complaint against Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. ("Central Rivers"). As permitted by Commission rules, Central Rivers filed a *Request for Mediation and to Suspend Schedule*. OPC filed a response indicating its willingness to participate in mediation. OPC also requested the Commission limit the amount of time for mediation to no longer than three months. The Commission will appoint Senior Regulatory Law Judge Daniel Jordan as mediator and direct him to provide regular status updates.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. All proceedings in this matter are stayed, pending the outcome of mediation, except as otherwise indicated in this order.
2. Senior Regulatory Law Judge Daniel Jordan is appointed as mediator.

3. Judge Jordan shall provide periodic reports to the Commission on the progress of the mediation. Should any party decide it no longer wishes to participate in mediation, it shall inform Judge Jordan and file a notification with the Commission.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
