

3. On September 10, 2020, the Commission received a payment of \$1,009.31, which covered the delinquent FY20 Commission assessment owed by Central Rivers.

4. On September 29, 2020, the Commission received a payment of \$1,040.73 from Elm Hills, which covered the delinquent FY21 Commission assessment owed by Central Rivers.

5. Elm Hills has now paid the entirety of the delinquent assessments owed by Central Rivers.

6. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116 governs the dismissal of cases brought before the Commission. Since no prepared testimony has been filed, or oral evidence offered, Staff may dismiss its case against Central Rivers voluntarily, without an order from the Commission.¹

7. Thus, Staff provides notice of dismissal of its complaint against Central Rivers.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Notice of Dismissal*.
