**ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING**

On December 4, 2012, Lincoln County Sewer and Water, LLC filed a request for an increase in its sewer operating revenues of \$13,382.00 and \$7,569.00 in its water revenues.

On July 2, the Staff of the Commission informed the Commission that Staff and the company were unable to reach an agreement and requested an evidentiary hearing. Accordingly, the Office of the Public Counsel requested that the Commission hold a Local Public Hearing. The Commission will therefore set a Local Public Hearing and in a subsequent order, direct the parties to file a procedural schedule with a proposed date for an evidentiary hearing.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. A Local Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, August 20, 2013, in the Board of Aldermen Meeting Room at:

2. A question and answer/informational session will begin at 6:00 pm.
3. The Commission will take on-the-record testimony from customers beginning at the conclusion of the 6:00 pm session. The hearing will not proceed beyond 9:00 pm.
4. Lincoln County Sewer and Water, LLC shall notify its customer of this hearing.
5. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall notify members of the General Assembly representing the residents in the service area of the company and to the news media serving the residents in the service area of Lincoln County Sewer and Water, LLC.
6. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall notify the county commissioners of Lincoln County, Missouri.
7. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
