On April 2, 2014, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued its Report and Order in this rate case. On May 8, Lincoln County Sewer & Water filed a motion to for the Commission to establish the expenses associated with the rate case. Thereafter, the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel filed pleadings opposing the company’s request. Finally, on May 21, 2014, the company filed a reply to Staff and Public Counsel’s pleadings.

The Commission will set a hearing to consider evidence of rate case expense and to hear the parties’ arguments.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. An evidentiary hearing shall be held on June 13, 2014, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
