ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

On March 8, 2022, S. K. & M. Water and Sewer Company initiated staff assisted rate cases with the Commission, requesting an increase of \$4,000 in its annual water system operating revenues and \$8,000 in its annual sewer system operating revenues.¹ On March 22, 2022, Commission's Staff (on behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel) submitted a joint list of proposed locations, dates, and times for a local public hearing.² In the filing, Staff and OPC state that a virtual public hearing would be the best option for these two cases. The Commission will set the local public hearing based on the proposed suggestions.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A public hearing is scheduled to begin at **6:00 p.m.** on **April 21, 2022**, via the internet-based video and teleconferencing service, Cisco WebEx. The public hearing will begin with a question-and-answer session and formal public comments to the Commission will begin immediately following the conclusion of the question-and-answer session.

2. No later than ten days before the local public hearing, S. K. & M. Water and Sewer Company shall provide notice of the public hearing to each of its customers, and shall file a status report with the Commission detailing the notice, and how and when it was delivered.

3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of the local public hearing.

4. S. K. & M. Water and Sewer Company, Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions.

5. To facilitate an orderly presentation that can be preserved for the record, members of the public who wish to participate in the hearing are requested to sign-up by sending their first and last names, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses to pscinfo@psc.mo.gov, or by calling (800) 392-4211 by 5:00 p.m. the day before the hearing. When signing up, please reference File No. SR-2022-0239.

6. To attend the hearing by telephone, at the time of the hearing call 1-650-479-3207 (toll number), listen to the prompt, and enter meeting number (access code) 2450 892 1279, followed by # (pound/hashtag symbol). If prompted for a password, enter 2022. To attend by video/internet, visit the website at www.webex.com or download the Cisco WebEx Meetings application. At the hearing time, enter the corresponding access code and password listed above.
