## ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On Friday, August 10, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule for this case. The motion explains that the parties have filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement in a companion case - WR-2007-0216 - that will also resolve all issues in this case. The procedural schedule for this case requires the parties to file rebuttal testimony on Monday, August 13. Public Counsel requests that the Commission suspend the procedural schedule until the Commission decides whether to accept the stipulation and agreement. Public Counsel represents that Missouri-American Water Company and Home Builders Association of St. Louis and Eastern Missouri, Inc. join in their motion.

Since a stipulation and agreement has been filed that may resolve all issues in this case, it would be a waste of resources to require the parties to file testimony before the Commission decides whether to accept that stipulation and agreement. Therefore, the Commission will suspend the procedural schedule until further order of the Commission.

- 1. The procedural schedule previously established for this case is suspended pending further order of the Commission.
