
STAFF RECOMMENDATION



Subject: Staff Recommendation to Approve Proposed Basic Local Exchange Tariff and
Access Tariff

Date: May 9, 2000

Fidelity Communications Services I, Inc. (Fidelity), was granted certificate of service authority by this Commission in Case No. TA-2000-191. In the Commission's Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local Exchange Telecommunications Services, effective December 14, 1999, the Commission ordered Fidelity to file tariff sheets within 30 days after the effective date of a Commission order approving an interconnection agreement. Fidelity has an interconnection agreement with Sprint Missouri, Inc. (Sprint) which was approved by this Commission on January 11, 2000 (Case No. TO-2000-351). On April 3, 2000, Fidelity submitted a proposed tariff (P.S.C. MO No. 1) to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services and a proposed tariff (P.S.C. MO No. 2) to provide access services. At the request of the Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff), Fidelity filed substitute sheets on May 9, 2000.

Fidelity's proposed basic local exchange tariff, as amended, conforms to the standards as set forth in the Commission's Order in Case No. TA-2000-191. Fidelity will be providing basic local exchange telecommunications services on a facilities and resold basis throughout all exchanges served by Sprint. Fidelity's tariff reflects that Rolla is the only exchange Fidelity proposes to serve at this time. Fidelity's tariff contains a list of the waivers approved by the Commission in its Order and is similar to other CLEC tariffs previously approved by the Commission.

Fidelity's proposed access service tariff covers the provision of access services to intrastate interexchange customers. Fidelity's proposed access rates are no higher than those of the incumbent local exchange company, Sprint.
