### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant approval of the Interconnection Agreement between Missouri Telecom, Inc. and GTE Midwest Incorporated, filed on February 9, 2000.
- 2. The agreement incorporates the terms of the interconnection agreement between GTE Midwest Incorporated and AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. In Case No. TO-97-63 the Commission, pursuant to Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, approved the terms of the interconnection agreement between GTE Midwest Incorporated and AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc.
- 3. The Staff notes that in the application, GTE Midwest Incorporated takes the position that if any change is made in the interconnection agreement between it and AT&T, then

this agreement should also automatically be modified to reflect those changes since GTE Midwest Incorporated only made these terms available due to the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(i).

WHEREFORE, because the Commission determined in Case No. TO-97-63, that the terms set forth in this agreement satisfy the standard set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) in that they do not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and do not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity, the Staff recommends the Commission enter an Order Approving Interconnection Agreement.
