On July 15, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed with the Commission one (1) tariff sheet with an issue date of July 15, 2009, and a proposed effective date of September 1, 2009, to add the quarterly cost adjustment for the second quarter of 2009 as required by GMO's Quarterly Cost Adjustment Rider, which the Commission approved in Case No. HR-2005-0450. GMO's filing included workpapers consisting of four worksheets showing its calculation of the quarterly cost adjustment for the second quarter of 2009.

The Commission's Energy Department Staff (Staff) has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet, and based on GMO's workpapers Staff is of the opinion that the quarterly cost adjustment for the second quarter of 2009 has been calculated in accordance with the provisions of the Quarterly Cost Adjustment Rider (See attached Memo). Staff therefore recommends that the Commission approve the following proposed tariff sheet, as filed on July 15, 2009, to become effective on September 1, 2009, as requested by GMO, or permit the tariff sheet to go into effect by operation-of-law:

The Staff has verified that GMO is not delinquent on any assessment or the filing of its 2008 annual report. The Staff is not aware of any other matter pending before the Commission that affects or is affected by this tariff filing.

On July 15, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, (GMO) filed a Quarterly Cost Adjustment (QCA) for steam service in St. Joseph, Missouri, per the Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. HR-2005-0450, as modified or amended in Case No. HR-2009-0092 for steam service sales prior to July 1, 2009. The July 15 filing describes how GMO calculated the difference between GMO's actual fuel costs for generating steam and the QCA base costs during the second quarter of 2009 and describes how GMO calculated the QCA for the next 12 month recovery period from September 1, 2009 through August 31, 1010.

The procedure for the calculation of the QCA for steam service sales occurring prior to July 1, 2009 is set out in Revised Sheets 6.1 through 6.4 of GMO's tariff, entitled "Quarterly Cost Adjustment Rider for Steam."

I have reviewed the data and mathematical calculations provided by GMO. The calculations are correct, satisfy the standards set forth on Revised Sheets 6.1-6.4 of GMO's tariff, and are consistent with previous QCA tariff filings.
