STAFF REPORT ON CASE STATUS

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COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through one of its attorneys, and for its Report in response to a Commission Order entered on September 7, 2000, directing the Staff to file a status report on this case, states as follows:

1. The Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement) approved by the Commission in this matter provided, among other things, that House Springs Sewer Company (House Springs) would pay, through an escrow arrangement, Commission assessments amounting to \$41,093.52, in the event House Springs' assets were sold. Alternatively, this Agreement provided that the assessments owed by House Springs would also be paid when and if the net proceeds of the sale of the assets of the Imperial Utility Corporation (Imperial) were distributed to its owners.

2. Staff would respectfully report to the Commission that none of the foregoing events in connection with House Springs or Imperial have occurred. Specifically, House Springs' assets have not been sold, and, the proceeds of the sale of the assets of Imperial have not been distributed to its owners because those proceeds are the subject of ongoing litigation.

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3. Additionally, Staff would advise the Commission that House Springs is currently operating under the terms of a Court approved consent decree. This decree has the Missouri Department of Natural Resources as a party, and one of the decree's terms is that House Springs be sold no later than December 31, 2000.

4. Staff will continue to monitor this case and will advise the Commission when there has been a change in factual circumstances.
