Intermedia Communications Inc. (Intermedia) states in its <u>APPLICATION OF INTERMEDIA COMMUNICATIONS INC.</u> FOR APPROVAL OF AN INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT UNDER THE TELECOMMUNCIATIONS ACT OF 1996 (Application), that it wishes to replace its current interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), approved by Order of this Commission issued 3/7/97, with the interconnection agreement submitted with its instant Application. It states that the instant interconnection agreement is virtually and in all material respects identical to, and is an adoption of, the Interconnection Agreement between SWBT and AT&T which previously was approved by this Commission in Case Nos. TO-97-40 and TO-98-115.

Based on the above assertions, Staff recommends approval of the replacement of Intermedia's initial interconnection agreement with SWBT, Case No. TO-97-260, with the instant agreement.
