- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the proposed Resale Agreement appears to meet the standards set forth in Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act) in that the Agreement does not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not party to the Agreement and does not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity.
- 2. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant approval of the Resale Agreement pursuant to the Act.
