1. The parties reached a settlement of this case in principle and requested suspension of the

procedural schedule. On August 18, 2020, the Commission issued its Order Suspending

Procedural Schedule and directed the filing of a status report by September 1, 2020.

2. The parties are continuing to work together on settlement language and intend to file a written settlement agreement shortly. It appears that the Company will not need to propose revised FAC tariff sheets at this time, and that, instead, the current FAC rate will continue until it is reviewed and determined with the next FAC filing, which is scheduled for October 1, 2020.
