ORDER GRANTING SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
STAFF RECOMMENDATION

In an order issued on May 12, 2006, the Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation by May 26, 2006, regarding MCC Telephony of Missouri, Inc.'s application for waiver of compliance with the requirement of 4 CSR 240-32. On May 25, Staff filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file its recommendation. The Commission granted Staff's motion and directed Staff to file its recommendation on or before June 23, 2006.

On June 15, Staff filed a motion requesting a second extension of time to file its recommendation. The Staff has agreed to a request by MCC Telephony for additional time to respond to Staff data requests. Due to the resulting delay in discovery, Staff requires additional time to receive and review MCC Telephony's responses, and to conduct follow up, if needed. The Staff requested that it be allowed until July 11, 2006, to file its recommendation.

Staff's motion is reasonable and will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation regarding MCC Telephony of Missouri, Inc.'s application by July 11, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on June 19, 2006.
